

CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS

On **Saturday, September 16, 2017**, Harris County Public Health (HCPH) will conduct a [Community Assessment for Public Health Emergency Response](#) (CASPER) in selected neighborhoods of Southeast Harris County (League City, Friendswood, Webster, Seabrook, Nassau Bay, & El Lago) and we need your help!

This effort will involve teams of HCPH employees and volunteers conducting surveys to assess how prepared Harris County residents were during Hurricane Harvey. Twenty volunteer teams will visit randomly selected neighborhoods to conduct surveys to gather this information.

ELIGIBILITY

Those wishing to volunteer at the CASPER must:

- All individual volunteers must be aged 18 or older
- Register for the event **and** complete online training
- Be able to stand and walk for up to 8 hours
- Have your own method of transportation to the CASPER location
- Be able to commit to participating in the **entire event** on Friday or Saturday (preferably both to reduce the need for re-training)
 - Event hours for **Saturday, September 16, 2017** are **7:30 a.m. – 6:30 p.m.**
